A Bid Bond in the amount of 5 percent of the bid issued by an acceptable surety, executed by the Bidder, and payable to the order of the OWNER shall be submitted with each Bid. Cashier's Check will be accepted in lieu of Bid Bond.

The OWNER reserves the right to reject any or all bids or to waive any informalities or minor defects in the bidding.

Bids may be held by the OWNER for a period of **ninety (90)** days from the date of the opening of the Bids for the purpose of reviewing the Bids and investigating the qualifications of Bidders, prior to awarding the Contract.

If the contract is to be awarded, it will be awarded to the lowest Bidder whose evaluation by Owner indicates to Owner that the award will be in the best interests of the Project. The Owner reserves the right to determine the best interests of the Project based on Owner's first-hand experience with or knowledge about Bidders, including information regarding safety records of Bidders provided in the Greater Texoma Utility Authority's Contractor Qualification Statement, and may award the contract based on a preference because of such experience or knowledge.

All qualified applicants will receive consideration for employment without regard to race, color, religion, sex, or national origin.
