

REQUEST FOR PROPOSALS

Sealed proposals addressed to the Greater Texoma Utility Authority (GTUA, Owner) on behalf of the City of Sherman will be received at the offices of the Director of Utilities and Engineering, Sherman City Hall, 220 W. Mulberry, Sherman, TX 75090, between 8 A.M. and 2 P.M. on May 19, 2016 for furnishing all necessary material, equipment and labor required for the construction of the following project:

CITY OF SHERMAN WWTP BIOSOLIDS DEWATERING PROJECT

The project includes, but is not necessarily limited to screw press dewatering equipment in a metal building on a pier supported foundation, a concrete air mix tank and appurtenances.

The screw press equipment bids will be received at the same opening. Selected equipment purchase will be assigned to the successful construction bidder. Bid allowances are defined in the bid documents.

Bidders must submit with their bids a Cashier's Check or a Certified Check in the amount of five (5%) percent of the maximum amount of bid payable without recourse to the Owner or a proposal bond in the same amount. The successful Bidder will be required to furnish a performance bond in the amount of the contract, and a payment bond for the protection of all claimants supplying labor and materials.

The Owner reserves the right to determine the best interests of the Project based upon the Owner's firsthand experience with or knowledge about Bidders, including information regarding safety.

In determining to whom to award a contract, GTUA may consider, among other things:

1. The purchase price;
2. The reputation of the vendor and the vendor's goods or services;
3. The quality of the vendor's goods or services;
4. The extent to which the goods or services meet GTUA's needs;
5. The vendor's past relationship with GTUA;
6. The total long-term cost to the GTUA to acquire the vendor's goods or services;
8. Any other relevant factor specifically listed in the request for bids or proposals; and
9. The safety record of the bidder, of the firm, corporation, partnership, or institution represented by the bidder, or of anyone acting for such a firm, corporation, partnership, or institution.
