

**ADVERTISEMENT AND INVITATION FOR BIDS
WATER SUPPLY WELL, GROUND STORAGE TANK, PUMPS & APPURTENANCES**

The Greater Texoma Utility Authority (GTUA) (Owner) on behalf of the City of Tom Bean, Texas will receive bids at the City of Tom Bean, City Hall, 201 South Britton Street, P.O. Box 659, Tom Bean, Texas 75489 until 2:00 p.m. on February 8, 2017. The envelope must be sealed and clearly marked “**WATER SUPPLY WELL, GROUND STORAGE TANK, PUMPS & APPURTENANCES**” (in the lower left hand corner). Bids will be publicly opened and read aloud at City Hall, 201 South Britton Street, P.O. Box 659, Tom Bean, Texas 75489 on February 8, 2017 at 2:00 p.m. for the following project:

Base Bid includes drilling and completing a 200 gpm (minimum) *Woodbine* formation potable water well, constructing a 125,000 gallon ground storage tank with pumps. The base bid also includes clearing and grubbing an area for the well location, chlorination facilities, electrical, SCADA, 500 l.f. of 6” water pipe with valves and fittings, and intruder resistant fencing.

Instructions to Bidders, Proposal Forms, Specifications, Plans and Contract Documents, etc., may be examined without charge, at the office of the Greater Texoma Authority, Texas, 5100 Airport Drive, Denison, Texas 75020, downloaded online at www.civcastusa.com without charge, or may be purchased at Cobb Fendley & Associates, 2801 Network Boulevard, Suite 800, Frisco, Texas 75034 for a fee of 75.00 non-refundable. Payment shall be made to Cobb Fendley & Associates.

A bid bond in the amount of 5 percent of the bid issued by an acceptable surety shall be submitted with each bid. A certified check or bank draft payable to the Greater Texoma Utility Authority or negotiable U.S. Government Bonds (as par value) may be submitted in lieu of the Bid Bond.

The successful Bidder must furnish performance and payment bonds each in the amount of 100 percent (100%) of the contract price from an approved Surety Company holding a permit from the State of Texas, to act as Surety.

The Greater Texoma Utility Authority reserves the right to reject any or all bids or to waive any informalities in the bidding. Bids may be held by GTUA for a period not to exceed 60 days from the date of the bid opening for the purpose of receiving bids and investigating the bidder’s qualifications prior to the contract award.

1. The contract will be contingent upon release of funds from the Water Development Board
2. Any contract or contracts awarded under this Invitation for Bids are expected to be funded in part by a loan from the Texas Water Development Board. Neither the State of Texas nor any of its departments, agencies, or employees are or will be a party to this Invitation for Bids or any resulting contract.
3. Equal Opportunity in Employment – All qualified applicants will receive consideration for employment without regard to race, color, religion, sex, handicap, age, handicap or national origin. Bidders on this work will be required to comply with the President’s Executive Order No. 11246, as amended by Executive Order 11375, and as supplemented in Department of Labor regulations 41 CFR Part 60.
