All questions must be submitted in writing, questions received less than four business days prior to the date for opening of Bids may not be answered. Addenda will be issued no later than 2 business days prior to the Bid opening.

This project includes installation of a temporary and permanent sanitary sewer discharge line, concrete paving and flatwork, concrete foundations, site grading, refurbishing of existing building, plumbing, electrical including standby generator, chemical dosing, detailed design, fabrication, and installation of a packaged wastewater treatment plant including blowers, polymer mixing pump, sludge pumps, and associated appurtenances, lift station pump replacement and associated controls, influent force main, disposal of sludge and contaminated soils, and all associated piping, electrical, instrumentation and control work at the **CITY OF GUNTER DOWNTOWN WASTEWATER TREATMENT PLANT**.

Bidders must submit a cashier's check, certified check, or acceptable bidder's bond with their proposal as a guarantee that the Bidder will enter into a contract for the project with the Owner within fifteen (15) days of Notice of Award of the contract. The security must be payable to Greater Texoma Utility Authority on behalf of the City of Gunter in the amount of five (5%) percent of the bid submitted. Contractor must execute the contract, bonds and certificates of insurance on the forms provided in the Contract Documents.

Contractors for this Project must pay no less than the prevailing wage rates for the area established by the Owner and included in the contract documents.

Performance and Payment Bonds are required, each in an amount of not less than one-hundred percent (100%) of the contract price, conditioned upon the faithful performance of the contract and upon payment of all persons supplying labor or furnishing materials. A 2-year Maintenance Bond in the amount of 10% of the contract price is required.

The Greater Texoma Utility Authority on behalf of the City of Gunter reserves the right to adopt the most advantageous interpretation of the bids submitted in the case of ambiguity or lack of clearness in stating proposal prices, to reject any or all bids, and/or waive formalities. Bids may not be withdrawn within sixty (60) days from date on which bids are opened.
