Greater Texoma Utility Authority/Bear Creek SUD are seeking proposals for an archeological survey associated with the Bear Creek SUD Water System Improvements Project, to include construction of a 2.0 MG ground storage tank, pump station facilities, and water lines.

Scope of Work: 1) Preparation of archeological survey in accordance with email from Texas Historic Commission email dated September 13, 2018.

The proposals will be evaluated to determine which firm has the best qualifications to fit the needs of Bear Creek SUD on this project.

Contract Terms

This contract is contingent upon release of funds from the Texas Water Development Board (TWDB). Any contract or contracts awarded under this Request for Qualifications (RFQ) are expected to be funded in part by a loan from the TWDB. Neither the State of Texas nor any of its departments, agencies or employees are or will be a party to this RFQ, or any resulting contract. RFQs are issued in accordance with Section 2254 of the Texas Government Code (Professional Services Act).

This contract is subject to the Environmental Protection Agency's (EPA) Disadvantaged Business Enterprise (DBE) Program, which includes EPA-approved fair share goals toward procurement of Minority and Women-owned Business Enterprise (M/WBE) firms.
