

Request for Proposals for Inspection Services

Lake Kiowa SUD, is seeking proposals for inspection services for the Lake Kiowa SUD Water Line Construction Project.

Scope of Work: Daily inspection during construction, contract coordination with Greater Texoma Utility Authority, Lake Kiowa SUD, Texas Water Development Board and Texas Commission on Environmental Quality.

Proposal: Furnish a Proposal which may include the following information: 1) Experience with inspection services associated with water systems, specifically water line construction 2) Project team overview; 3) Experience with TWDB funded projects; and 4) List of references with contact information.

Submission Requirements: If your firm is interested in being considered for this assignment, submit your proposal to General Manager, Greater Texoma Utility Authority, via email at drews@gtua.org no later than 3:00PM Tuesday October 2, 2018. The proposal must be in .pdf or .docx form.

Minimum Qualifications and Selection Criteria

The proposals will be evaluated to determine which firm has the best qualifications to fit the needs of Lake Kiowa SUD on this project.

Contract Terms

This contract is contingent upon release of funds from the Texas Water Development Board (TWDB). Any contract or contracts awarded under this Request for Qualifications (RFQ) are expected to be funded in part by a loan from the TWDB. Neither the State of Texas nor any of its departments, agencies or employees are or will be a party to this RFQ, or any resulting contract. RFQs are issued in accordance with Section 2254 of the Texas Government Code (Professional Services Act).

This contract is subject to the Environmental Protection Agency's (EPA) Disadvantaged Business Enterprise (DBE) Program, which includes EPA-approved fair share goals toward procurement of Minority and Women-owned Business Enterprise (M/WBE) firms. EPA rules require that applicants and prime contractors make a good faith effort to award a fair share of contracts, subcontracts, and procurements to M/WBEs through demonstration of the six affirmative steps.
